# **CHEIF COMPLAINTS:**

22 male referred for DVT. had history of left leg DVT (CI, EI, CF, PSF) veins, doppler on 26/12/19 and repeated on 17/8/20, showed persistent thrombosis. Patient had gastric ligation and travel before the DVT. Lupus anticoagulant positive, factor V heterozygous, but not specified since the report is merely 3 sentences. No symptoms of swelling or pain. Patient is on apixaban 5 mg bid.

Assessment and plan;

extensive DVT with heterozygous factor V and lupus anticoagulant, was on apixaban. Need to repeat testing for lupus anticoagulants/ doppler for left side, and if still thrombosis need to switch to warfarin rather than any of the direct oral anticoagulants.
